Radisson Road Trail

Section 1 of the trail is a 1.90-mile segment running from Cloud Dr south to 109th Ave. The northern portion of the trail connects to The Lakes Loop providing a spectacular ride along the lakes. Don't miss the wetland trail loop out of East Lake Park. The southern portion of the trail connects to Tournament Players Pkwy, Deacons Park and the Club West Loop. Don't miss the island park connected by trail bridges on this loop.

Section 2 of the trail is a 2.69-mile segment running from 109th Ave south to 95th Ave. Taking the Radisson Road Trail south connects, using 105th Ave, to Airport Park, Blaine Soccer Complex and the National Sports Center. This trail also connects, using Town Square Drive, to Blaine City Hall. At 95th Avenue and Radisson Road an on street trail route connects east to the Lexington Avenue Trail.

Section 3 of the trail is a 1.87-mile segment running from 95th Ave south to 85th Ave. Beginning at 95th Ave, the trail runs south along sidewalks on Flanders St to 93rd Ave. The trail splits going south along sidewalks on Flanders St to Kane Meadows Park and east to an existing off street trail to 89th Ave. The remainder of the trail is an off street corridor running through the city's open space.

Lexington Avenue Trail


Section 4 of the trail is a 2-mile segment from 125th Ave south to 109th Ave. The trail connects to Lochness Park, the second largest park in the city. A trail is provided in the park around Lochness Lake.

Section 5 of the trail is a 1-mile segment from 109th Ave south to North Rd that crosses over Interstate 35W. The trail has access to retail and restaurants in The Village Shopping Center using Pheasant Ridge Drive.

Section 6 of the trail is a 2.05-mile segment that runs from North Rd south to 85th Ave. The trail connects to Centennial Elementary School and Centennial High School using North Rd. The trail also connects with Centennial Green Park using Austin St. The trail continues south between Edgewood Rd and Flowerfield Rd along Lexington Ave using an off street corridor through the cities of Lexington and Circle Pines. The trail continues south with amazing views of Rice Creek Chain of Lakes Park to the east, access to Austin Park using 85th Ln and finishing at 85th Ave.
